## Dear Pastor:

Abortion leaves one dead and one walking but wounded mother. Abortion is a subject fraught with the anguish of mothers and fathers who sometimes rely on pastors like you during their search for answers to the pregnancy and for genuine spiritual healing if an abortion occurred.

Given that human life begins at conception, and given that nothing is added afterwards except food, water, and air, we reject current case law that has arbitrarily decreed life begins at birth. No judicial pen can arbitrarily re-write God's truth of Psalm 139, Isaiah 1:17, Proverbs 24:11-12, and Ephesians 2:10.

NH Right to Life consequently seeks legal restoration of respect for all human life in peaceful, persistent, and prayerful ways. One way is our annual March for Life day, which starts and ends in Christ-like fellowship. The marching part serves as a declaration of the pro-life Truth to a numbed society. It is also a day of rejuvenation for NH pro-lifers who grow weary facing pro-abortion successes like the Court decisions suspending the partial birth abortion ban and the continuing experiments on cloned human life.

We are painfully aware that pro-life activism can remind some women of difficult circumstances they may have endured with an unexpected pregnancy. Still, we prayerfully recognize a responsibility to witness on behalf of the unborn babies now in jeopardy by "choice". You can join us in this pro-life endeavor by posting the enclosed flyer on your bulletin boards. Additionally, a notice in your Sunday Bulletin would be most appreciated. You are welcome to use all or any or part of this message you see fit:
