Allan Parker, President of The Justice Foundation, is a former Professor of Law at St. Mary's University in San Antonio, Texas, where he taught Education Law and Civil Procedure. He taught International Human Rights at St. Mary's Institute on World Legal Problems in Innsbruck, Austria in 1992.
